Now semester 2 is finished and the pupils have a well needed mid term recess.

As we mentioned in our previous newsletter a new curriculum was introduced, valid for all schools in Kenya. This means that a preparatory pre-school class must be added. S:t Christine has got both facilities and personnel, but costs for school uniforms, utensils, desks and meals will increase.

The main road Kisumu – Kisii Highway will be widened, which forces us to replace the school's fence facing the road, and the boys' and teachers' toilets must be moved or replaced.

Last week the S:t Christine Foundation and the school's management team held a meeting to review the economy, projects and school work. The conclusion was that everything goes as planned.

Albinus Odada is still present and will confer with the road construction staff to minimize the damage.
