Closed schools in a country where very few have access to internet affect the pupils very severely. Since the school re-opened for the graduation classes, i.a. 8th grade, teachers and students have worked hard. During a few weeks the tuition was in the form of boarding school and the 8th-graders lived in the school and worked intensely together with their teachers, who are very anxious that the pupils reach best possible results. Education, meals, hygiene and sleeping accommodation were managed thanks to a fantastic staff, both teachers, managers and other personnel. The results show that all the pupils in 8th grade reached more than 200 points, which is the limits for admittance to secondary school. It's sad that not all custodians have the economic means to let the children continue, but the school's staff make everything they can to help the pupils apply for scholarships for further education.
